28 projects honored at the Community Action Award Gala - Human Act Prize 2023

On the evening of December 11, at Hoan Kiem Lake Theater, the Human Act Prize 2023 Gala Night took place with the theme "Pioneer Imprint".

This is an annual national award to honor and promote projects for <u>the community</u>, and to properly recognize organizations, businesses and individuals who are making efforts to contribute to society.

"Among the nearly 130 entries sent to us, there are many individuals, organizations and units that quietly started their journey several decades ago. They work, test and adjust, and worry about ways to improve their programs/projects to become more systematic and professional, to create even stronger impacts, thereby bringing many changes to an area, or simply helping individual lives. Their concern, steadfast belief and enthusiasm are endless inspiration for us - the organizers of the award", he emphasized.

According to the Organizing Committee, to ensure the transparency of the award, all participating projects must go through a strict application process, including requirements to provide detailed content and documents. Right from the preliminary round, reporters directly met and made many field trips to learn about the project, telling the community the stories, methods and models of each project, as well as as the values that the community benefits from these projects.

From the 35 project profiles that reached the final round, the jury selected the best projects to award prizes. The Human Act Prize's award categories are evaluated based on criteria that ensure impact, sustainability, commitment, creativity and community spread.

Specifically, the Community Action Award categories of Nhan Dan Newspaper – Human Act Prize 2023 with the theme "Pioneer Imprint" include:

1. The Ideas for the Community category honors projects with feasible implementation ideas that contribute to promoting the community in a more positive and sustainable direction.

This category honors 3 projects: "Medicine cabinet for children" by Genestory Joint Stock Company; "Support for cancer patients of" Community Medicine Organization; "Everlasting stories of people" by Ethnicity Vietnam.

- 2. The Project category honors groundbreaking community projects that solve urgent social problems, including:
- The Timely Project honors initiatives that effectively respond to urgent issues and a willingness to commit to the community. This category honors two projects: "Volunteer Social Platform" of Military Commercial Joint Stock Bank (MBBank); "Zero Tet Mini Supermarket" of Phu Nhuan Jewelry Joint Stock Company (PNJ).



The Timely Project honors initiatives that effectively respond to urgent issues and the spirit of willingness to commit to the community.

- Prospect Project honors projects that have the ability to develop quickly and widely in the future. The category honors 4 projects: TokyoLife Angel of IntelLife Joint Stock Company; Raising Lieutenant Duong Hai Anh's baby Moc Chau and his teammates; Fly To Sky charity group of Le Van Phuc (born 2004); MOMO piggy bank.
- Project Resilience honors admirable efforts to sustain and grow long-term community impact. This category honors 4 projects: Stand Tall Vietnam Dairy Fund (Vietnam Dairy Joint Stock Company); Connecting love with the Golden Lotus (Vietnam Airlines); Hope Fund operated by VnExpress Newspaper and FPT Joint Stock Company; Turn off the lights and turn on ideas (BOO Trading Joint Stock Company).
- The Inspire Project honors community activities with high humanity, the ability to spread and replicate, activating the great power of the community. This category honors 5 projects: Raising Children by Hoang Hoa Trung; Viettel's Heart for You; FAS Angel on duty on accident–prone roads to promptly help people; Salt Cancer Initiative working with a common purpose for the cancer patient community; Loan Fund of writer Isabelle Müller to help the most vulnerable children in Vietnam have a better life.

• The Sustainability Project honors scientifically engineered initiatives that deliver outstanding long-term and profound impact on communities. This category honors 5 projects: GreenPlan Project of Traphaco Joint Stock Company; Unilever's plastic circular economy; Sustainable Development Fund - Six Senses biodiversity conservation project in Ninh Van Bay (Khanh Hoa); Safe House Project of Living Foundation; Smart rice farming to adapt to climate change in the Mekong Delta by Binh Dien Fertilizer Joint Stock Company.

3. The landmark Human Act Prize category, honoring actions that bring positive and sustainable contributions to the community, honored the 5 best initiatives. That project is: Vinamilk Pathways to Dairy Net Zero Action Program of Vietnam Dairy Products Joint Stock Company; Connecting the strength of the natural disaster prevention community to establish the Natural Disaster Prevention Community Fund run by Mr. Phan Dien, former Politburo member, former Standing Secretary of the Secretariat; For a better life by L'Oréal Vietnam; Action to overcome post-war landmine consequences in Vietnam by Norwegian People's Aid (NPA) Vietnam; Changing the nature of Vietnam's dairy industry on the foundation of sustainable development, for public health by TH Group Joint Stock Company.

Not only honoring and spreading, Nhan Dan newspaper's Community Action Award also accompanies, orients and connects all individuals and groups that have, are and will carry responsibility for the community. community in their journey with the goal of making all community activities in Vietnam transparent, scientific, effective and humane.
