

## Honoring 28 community action projects

(CPV) - On the evening of December 11, at Hoan Kiem Lake Theater, Hanoi, 28 excellent projects and ideas were selected by the Organizing Committee of Nhan Dan Newspaper - Human Act Prize 2023 to be presented. Awards.

Human Act Prize 2023 was initiated by Nhan Dan Newspaper in an effort to find pioneering units and individuals who dare to take the first steps on a journey full of difficulties and challenges. After more than 3 years of incubating ideas and 70 days of intensive activities, the Human Act Prize 2023 has reached the end of its first year's journey with the theme "Pioneering Imprint".



Comrade Lai Xuan Mon, Member of the Party Central Committee, Standing Deputy Head of the Central Propaganda Department awarded the Human Act Prize to 5 excellent projects and initiatives.

In the first year of organization, the Human Act Prize 2023 had 129 applications submitted for the award. Besides projects from individuals and domestic businesses, there are also many projects from international organizations. Many projects have been implemented persistently for decades with high commitment and sustainability. In addition, there are also small but extremely creative projects that are pervasive and have great impact.

According to the Organizing Committee, to ensure the transparency of the award, all participating projects must go through a strict application process, including requirements to provide detailed content and documents. Right from the preliminary round, reporters directly met and made many field trips to learn about the project, telling the community the stories, methods and models of each project, as well as as the values that the community benefits from these projects.

From the 35 project profiles that entered the Final Round, the Jury selected the best projects to award prizes. The Human Act Prize's award categories are evaluated based on criteria that ensure impact, sustainability, commitment, creativity and community spread.

At the awards ceremony, the Organizing Committee awarded the Community Idea Award to 3 projects: "Medicine cabinet for children" of Genestory Joint Stock Company; "Supporting cancer patients" by the Community Medicine Organization; "Stories of eternal people" by

Ethnicity Vietnam.

The Timely Project Award category honored two projects: "Volunteer Social Platform" of Military Commercial Joint Stock Bank (MBBank); Mini Tet Supermarket 0 VND" of Phu Nhuan Jewelry Joint Stock Company (PNJ);

The Promising Project Award category honors 4 projects: TokyoLife Angel of IntelLife Joint Stock Company; Project ecosystem "Raising children in Moc Chau"; Fly To Sky charity group; MOMO Piggy Bank;

The Persistent Project Award category honors 4 projects: Stand Tall Vietnam Dairy Fund (Vietnam Dairy Joint Stock Company); Connecting love with the Golden Lotus (Vietnam Airlines); Hope Foundation; Turn off the lights and turn on ideas (BOO Trading Joint Stock Company);

The Inspirational Project Award category honors 5 projects: Raising Children; Heart for you; FAS Angel; Salt Cancer Initiative; LOAN Fund;

The most important award category of the Human Act Prize 2023 was awarded to 5 excellent initiatives including: Vinamilk Pathways to Dairy Net Zero Action Program (Vietnam Dairy Products Joint Stock Company); For a better life (LOréal Vietnam); Action to overcome the consequences of landmines after the war in Vietnam (Norwegian People's Aid (NPA) Vietnam); Changing the nature of Vietnam's dairy industry on the basis of sustainable development, for community health (TH Group Joint Stock Company).

At the awards Gala, touching stories were shared by the awarded groups and individuals, contributing to spreading good things, thereby encouraging more initiatives and actions for the community. /.
