

## 28 projects and initiatives for the Vietnamese community were honored at the Human Act Prize 2023



After more than 3 years of incubating ideas and 70 days of urgent activities, the Human Act Prize 2023 has found the most outstanding projects, ideas and initiatives for the community to honor at the Gala night and awards ceremony, taking place on the evening of December 11 at Ho Guom Theater, Hanoi.

The Program Organizing Committee received 129 applications for the award. Besides projects from individuals and domestic businesses, there are also a number of projects from international organizations. Many projects have been implemented persistently for decades with high commitment and sustainability. In addition, there are also small but extremely creative projects that are pervasive and have great impact. To ensure the transparency of the award, all participating projects must go through a strict application process, including requirements to provide detailed content and documents.

Right from the preliminary round, in addition to the direct appraisal by the Board of Examiners, reporters from many newspapers also met and made many field trips to learn about the project and tell the community what they learned. the story, methods and models of each project, as well as the values that the community benefits from these projects.

From the 35 project profiles that entered the Final Round, the Jury selected the best projects, ideas, and programs to award. The award "Human Act Prize" is organized by Nhan Dan Newspaper, with the companionship of the Ministry of Labor, War Invalids and Social Affairs, the Ministry of Natural Resources and Environment, and the Ministry of Science and Technology. , with the coordination of VCCorp Joint Stock Company and sponsor Bac A Bank Diamond.

The award aims to honor individuals and organizations that have made positive contributions to society through prestigious community initiatives and projects, bringing long-term and sustainable effects.

categories of the Human Act Prize 2023 are evaluated based on criteria that ensure impact, sustainability, level of commitment, creativity and spread in the community.

1. The Ideas **for the Community category** honors projects with feasible implementation ideas, contributing to promoting the community in a more positive and sustainable direction, awarded to: Medicine cabinet for children of Genestory Joint Stock Company; Cancer Patient Support Project of Community Medicine; Ethnicity Vietnam's eternal story.

2. The Project category honors groundbreaking community projects that solve urgent social problems, including:

- **Timely Project** honors initiatives to effectively respond to urgent issues and willingness to commit to the community. Awarded to: Social charity foundation

of Military Commercial Joint Stock Bank MB Bank; and 0 VND Tet Mini Supermarket of Phu Nhuan Jewelry Joint Stock Company.



- **The Prospect Project** honors projects with the ability to develop quickly and widely in the future, awarded to: Angel project of IntelLife Joint Stock Company; Ecosystem of Moc Chau Children's Raising Project; Fly to Sky charity group of Le Van Phuc (19 years old); Momo Piggy Bank of Momo Company.



- **The Persistence Project** honors admirable efforts to maintain and develop long-term impact for the community, awarded to: Stand Tall Vietnam Milk Fund of Vietnam Dairy Products Joint Stock Company (Vinamilk); Connecting love with the Golden Lotus of Vietnam Airlines; Hope Foundation's Hope Foundation supports children in disadvantaged areas; Turn off the lights Turn on ideas initiative of BOO Trading Joint Stock Company.




- **Inspiration Project** honors community activities with high humanity, the ability to spread and replicate, activating the great strength of the community, awarded to: Raising Children project by Mr. Hoang Hoa Central; Heart for You by Viettel Telecommunications Corporation (Viettel Telecom); FAS Angel first aid support; Salt Cancer Initiative's Salt Cancer Initiative; Supporting disadvantaged children for a better future by LOAN Foundation.



- **The Sustainability Project** honors scientifically built initiatives that bring outstanding long-term and profound impacts to the community, awarded to: GreenPlan of Traphaco Joint Stock Company; Unilever Vietnam's plastic circular economy; Six Senses NInh Van Bay Sustainable Development Fund; Safe House project of the Sustainable Living Community Development Support Fund; Smart rice farming program to adapt to climate change in the Mekong Delta of Binh Dien Fertilizer Joint Stock Company.



**3. The Human Act Prize** category is a landmark, honoring actions that bring positive and sustainable contributions to the community, awarded to: Vinamilk Pathways to Dairy Net Zero Action Program of Dairy Products Joint Stock Company Vietnam; program Connecting community strength to prevent natural disasters of the Community Foundation for Natural Disaster Prevention; L'Oréal Vietnam's For a Better Life project; project to overcome post-war bomb and mine consequences of Norwegian People's Aid (NPA) in Vietnam; Changing the nature of Vietnam's dairy industry on the foundation of sustainable development for public health of TH Group Joint Stock Company.



As of the Gala night, there were more than 90 media units from central to local levels accompanying the Award to spread the values sought by the Human Act Prize through more than 900 articles and 50 broadcast news reports. images, more than 350 articles on social media channels, reaching more than 4 million readers on multiple media platforms.

Sharing at the Award Ceremony, Mr. Le Quoc Minh - Member of the Party Central Committee, Deputy Head of the Central Propaganda Department, Editorin-Chief of Nhan Dan Newspaper, Chairman of the Vietnam Journalists Association, Head of the Organizing Committee of the Action Awards Program Community Action - said: " Among the nearly 130 entries sent to us, there are many individuals, organizations and units that have quietly started their journey for several decades. before. They work, test and adjust, and worry about ways to improve their programs/projects to become more systematic and professional, to create even stronger impacts, thereby bringing many changes to an area, or simply helping individual lives. Their concern, steadfast belief and enthusiasm are endless inspiration for us - the organizers of the award ."



Mr. Le Quoc Minh shared about the meaning of the Community Action Award program

" *Don't hesitate when doing good deeds, don't hesitate when spreading good stories in life*," Mr. Le Quoc Minh emphasized.

At the age of 86, Mr. Phan Dien, former Politburo member and former Standing Secretary of the Secretariat, still travels to people's homes in flooded areas in the Central region to send relief gifts, or check on sources. Check to see if there is enough clean water to supply people. Mr. Phan Dien started working for this community 15 years ago. He said he never thought he was old, never thought he was at retirement age. He shared that in 2007, the Central region suffered heavy damage due to floods. Realizing that people in the Central region suffered property damage every year due to storms and floods, he campaigned to establish the "Central Region Natural Disaster Prevention Support Fund", later renamed the "Community Prevention Fund". natural disasters" and expanding its scope to the whole country. Today, he is one of the people honored in the highest category - Human Act Prize.
