Isabelle Müller was born in 1964 in France, she is the youngest child in a family with a Vietnamese mother (Mrs. Dau Thi Cuc, self-proclaimed Loan) and a French father who fought in Vietnam. Since 1985 Isabelle Müller has worked as an interpreter and interpreter in Germany. Around the 1990s, she and her mother went to Southeast Asia many times, from there she had the opportunity to learn about Vietnamese roots and take notes. Since then, she has established the Loan Foundation in her mother's name to help poor Vietnamese children. She is the author of books from mother's love and Vietnamese love. Isabelle Müller's two books published in Vietnam are Loan - from the Life of a Phoenix and The Phoenix's Daughter - Hope is My Way.
